- 1. **Read and dance:** Find books and music about contemporary children in different countries. Invite children to dance to the music of different cultures.
- 2. Learn many greetings: Read Hello! Goodbye! by Aliki. Sing the song "Hello Everybody" (below) as you teach the word for hello in several languages.
