Relative Adverbs

Definition: A **relative adverb** is a word that talks about place, time, and reason for something. There are three relative adverbs that you can use in your sentences: where, when, and why.

This is the store **where** I bought my favorite backpack.
Here we are talking about a **place**.

I bought this backpack **when** I was nine years old.
Here we are talking about a **time**.

I don't know **why** my sister didn't pick a Spiderman backpack.
Here we are talking about the **reason**.
